Many factories, warehouses and other workplaces operate around the clock. Second and third shift workers must be protected during those hours when the front office is closed. The Weather Eagle 110® and Alert Eagle 120® automatically notify your workers of an impending weather or other emergency. Here's how it works:

- WE110/AE120 receives severe weather warnings for your location from the National Weather Service.
- The WE110/AE120 is often connected to the factory's public address system for automatic alerting.
- The WE110/AE120 is usually configured to only activate for tornado warnings for the subject county and the weekly test to ensure the system is working.
- The WE110/AE120 can dial a telephone activated PBX public address system with the optional telephone interface.
- The WE110/AE120 can be connected to two way radio systems.



This system has already saved lives! A WE110/AE120 in a Wisconsin factory automatically placed a tornado warning on their public address system. The WE110/AE120 activated over a minute before the municipal tornado siren system was activated. 250 workers safely made it their shelter area before a tornado ripped the roof off the factory! There were no injuries.
